

Ohio Historical Markers Grant Program

Purpose

The Ohio Historical Markers Grant Program was implemented as a way to help organizations and communities defray the cost of purchasing an Ohio Historical Marker.

How to Apply

- Indicate interest in applying for funding by responding affirmatively to "Check if applying for funding through Ohio Historical Markers Grant Program" on the application form.
- Applications are due and must be postmarked no later than May 1.

Awards

- Up to 10 marker applicants per year will be selected to receive \$1,000 toward defraying the total cost of a marker. Markers typically range in cost from \$3,180 to \$3,490 depending on the length of text desired.
- Please note that photos or other graphics incur an additional charge. Be sure to read the marker price list for details.
- Applications featuring topics with state and national significance may take precedence over those with local significance only.
- Applicants from counties with fewer historical markers may take precedence over those counties with numerous historical markers.
- Applicants who do not receive funding may choose to resubmit their application for the same topic in the following year or to pay for the total cost of the marker.

Notification

• Applicants will be notified within 90 days of the application deadline.
